

VACCINATIONS

- RABIES as required by law
- DISTEMPER (i.e., DHLPP, DHLPP+C)
Booster as recommended by your vet
 - Usually 1-yr or 3-yr booster
 - Or appropriate titer verification
- BORDETELLA
Booster as recommended by your vet
 - Usually every 6 to 12 months

PARASITE PREVENTION

I live in a woodland setting with deer and plenty of other wildlife which can carry fleas and ticks. For your dog's protection, PREVENTION is the ONLY sensible option.

Some form of parasite preventative is expected to be regularly administered to your dog — as recommended by your vet — either year-round or at least from April through November.

- HEARTWORM Prevention
- FLEA and TICK Prevention

Your signature on the Service Agreement Form attests that you regularly administer these important parasite preventatives.

Additionally, all dog-visitors will be inspected for fleas and ticks. If discovered, the dog will be treated immediately at the owner's expense for the protection of both my home and the other dogs on site.

GENERAL HEALTHCARE

ILLNESS: Any dog who arrives showing obvious signs of illness will NOT be allowed to enter the premises.

- e.g. coughing, runny nose, diarrhea, listlessness, etc.

If you're leaving town and your dog is ill, you need to contact your vet about in-hospital boarding.

VETERINARY TREATMENT: Any dog who develops obvious signs of illness or injury while in my care will be taken - solely at my discretion - to my local vet and the owner will be responsible for any and all expenses involved.

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
